6 WHEREAS, as the career exploration process evolves, we  
7 have the responsibility of supplying comprehensive and relevant  
8 information to our Nebraska high school students, to help them in  
9 developing important educational and vocational goals; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense develops  
11 and administers the ASVAB Career Exploration Program to assess  
12 capabilities of young people about to enter the military; and

13 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense also  
14 offers this award-winning program to high schools throughout the  
15 United States, including the State of Nebraska, at no cost to the  
16 schools or students and without military obligation, providing one  
17 of the most widely used and highly regarded career development  
18 programs in the world; and

19 WHEREAS, the ASVAB Career Exploration Program contains  
20 state-of-the-art career exploration materials that are easily  
21 integrated into schools' career guidance programs; and

22 WHEREAS, the Exploring Careers: The ASVAB Career  
23 Exploration Guide helps students to identify, understand, and  
24 organize information about their interests, skills, and  
25 work-related values, then identify suitable occupations, to  
26 investigate and further explore through the use of a variety of

1 career information resources; and

2 WHEREAS, nearly half of Nebraska high school students  
3 participate in the ASVAB Career Exploration Programs before  
4 graduation.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE  
6 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

7 1. That the Legislature recognize the week of March  
8 17-23, 2004, as ASVAB Career Exploration Program Week.
