5 Introduced by Erdman, 47; Smith, 48

6 WHEREAS, Bill Pile taught and coached six years at Sioux  
7 County High School where his wrestling team won the 1975 State  
8 Wrestling Championship and he was selected Class D wrestling coach  
9 of the year. His team holds the Class D record for consecutive  
10 duel wins having won thirty-three in a row and the record for  
11 consecutive regular season tournament championships of twenty-four  
12 wins; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Pile served as principal at Mullen High  
14 School for sixteen years during which time he was also athletic  
15 director, head coach for wrestling, girl's basketball, and golf as  
16 well as teaching an evening accounting class for Mid-Plains  
17 College. Also, while at Mullen, Mr. Pile was inducted into the  
18 Chadron State College Hall of Fame and served two-year terms in the  
19 positions of Loup Valley Conference Secretary and Loup Valley  
20 Conference President; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Pile held the position of superintendent for  
22 Leyton Public Schools and later shared superintendent for Leyton  
23 and Potter-Dix Public Schools; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Pile has received numerous awards and  
25 recognition including membership on an advisory committee to the  
26 State Department of Education for the development of the state

1 report card, induction into the Nebraska Wrestling Coaches Hall of  
2 Fame, recipient of the Distinguished Service Award from the  
3 Nebraska School Activities Association, and appointment by Governor  
4 Johanns to the board of the Coordinating Commission for  
5 Postsecondary Education; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Pile will be retiring this year; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Pile, throughout his professional coaching,  
8 teaching and administrative career, has touched the lives of  
9 numerous athletes, students, faculty, and staff by providing a  
10 challenging and positive learning environment as well as exemplary  
11 leadership.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE  
13 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

14 1. That the Legislature recognizes and congratulates  
15 Bill Pile for his many years of service to the schools and  
16 communities of Nebraska.
