The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1137 creates a process for city councils in cities of the first class to review and comment on grant applications for funds to develop low-income housing within the city's corporate limits or zoning jurisdiction.

Many groups sometimes apply for the same funds. LB 1137 proposes a process to coordinate and prioritize the applications. The reason for introducing this bill is to begin discussion of this issue by interested parties.
