AN ACT relating to counties; to amend section 22-119, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 22-112 and 22-171, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002; to change the boundary line between the counties of Butler and Colfax; to harmonize provisions; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
Be it enacted by the people of the state of Nebraska,
Section 1. Section 22-112, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002, is amended to read:

Sec. 2. Section 22-119, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. Section 22-171, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002, is amended to read:

22-171. The county of Platte is bounded as follows: Beginning Commencing at a point on the east line of township 16 north, range 1 east, said point being 3711.01 feet south of the northeast corner of section 1 , of said township, and assuming the east line of said section 1 to have a bearing

 3725.32 feet; thence $N \quad 70^{\circ} 17{ }^{\prime} 54 \prime \mathrm{~W}, 5359.26$ feet, to a point on the west line of township 17 north, range 1 east, said point being 904.43 feet north of the southwest corner of said township, thence south to the south bank of the main channel of the Platte River; thence west along said south bank to its intersection with the line dividing ranges 2 and 3 west; thence north by said line to the northwest corner of township 16 north, of range 2 west; thence west on the 4 th standard parallel to the eastern boundary of the former Pawnee Indian Reservation; thence west and north by the boundaries of said reservation to the line dividing ranges 4 and 5 west; thence north to the northwest corner of township 20 north, of range 4 west; thence east by the 5th standard parallel to the line dividing ranges 1 and 2 east; thence south to the place of beginning.

Sec. 4. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2004.
Sec. 5. Original section 22-119, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 22-112 and 22-171, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002, are repealed.
