LR 17, 18

Mr. President: LR 17CA by Senator Schrock is a proposed constitutional amendment to permit the Legislature to annually appropriate not more than 10 percent of the principal to the perpetual school funds; LR 18CA is a proposed constitutional amendment offered by Senator Redfield to authorize the Legislature to exempt a levy or part of a levy on homesteads. Notice of committee hearings have been received from the Government Committee, and Revenue, and Business and Labor Committee. A series of name adds: Senator Tyson to LB 475, Senator Redfield to LB 446, Senator Jones to LB 92, Senator Hudkins to LB 279, Senator Kremer to LB 117, Senator Stuhr to LB 300. And that's all I have at this time. (Building Maintenance Committee elected Senator Thompson as Chairperson, and Senator Tyson as Vice Chairperson. Legislative Program Evaluation Committee elected Senator Beutler as Chairperson, and Senator Price as Vice Chairperson, Legislative Journal pages 193-200.)
