ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 610-612 by title for the first time, Legislative Journal pages 229-230.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Speaker Bromm, you're recognized.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Just very briefly, we will convene tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. and we'll have a few Revisor bills to process and to work with on the floor. Tomorrow is the last day for bill introduction, would like to remind everyone, and we'll stay in business tomorrow for most of the morning to give you an opportunity to introduce bills that you may want to get in tomorrow. So I'm not sure what time we'll adjourn, but when we find there are no more bills coming in then we'll probably adjourn. So with that, Mr. President, I will...okay, with that, Clerk advises you need a few more minutes yet, and when we're done with that we'll adjourn. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Mr. Clerk, new bills, announcements, messages, or reports?

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 613-620 by title for the first time, Legislative Journal pages 230-231.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, new bills.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. New bills. (Read LB 621-630 by title for the first time.) Two constitutional amendments: LR 20CA by Senator Beutler, propose an amendment to Article V, section 1; LR 21CA by Senator Stuhr would propose an amendment to Article III, section 18.

In addition to those items, Mr. President, hearing notices from the Natural Resources Committee and Urban Affairs. An amendment to be printed, Senator Tyson to LB 265. And a series of name adds and withdrawals: Senator Schimek to add her name to LB 430; Senator Brown, LB 487; Senator Schimek, LB 474; Senator Mossey, LB 512; Senator Bromm, LR 15CA; Senator Bromm, LB 389; Senator Schimek, LB 401; and Senator Thompson, LB 32. Senator Engel would like to remove his name from LB 124; Senator Schimek from LB 124. And that's all that I have, Mr. President.
