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want to run for the Legislature. Can he hold that position up until the time he is elected? I mean, if he's running for that position. Or does he have to resign that position to run for a seat in the Legislature?

SENATOR McDONALD: Now, or if this passes? Or does that make a difference?

SENATOR JANSSEN: If this passes.

SENATOR McDONALD: Well, he still has the governing board that...where his employer is from, makes that decision whether he can hold both jobs. I mean, if their...if his employer said, no, you can't do that, we won't allow you to do that unless you quit your job, then he has to quit his job.

SENATOR JANSSEN: No, I'm not talking about someone working for the county. I'm talking about a county board, an elected official.

SENATOR McDONALD: That I don't know.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR McDONALD: You might ask Senator Schimek that.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR McDONALD: She was involved...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR McDONALD: ...in putting this together.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR JANSSEN: How about that that scenario? Oh.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Sorry, I didn't hear your question.
