construction is completed, will be a 75 percent federal and 25 percent state cost split. The second facility, a \$1.1 million crash rescue facility, will adjoin the organizational maintenance shop, and is programmed for funding in federal year '04. This facility will support two new seven-member engineer firefighting teams, and include two equipment work bays, plus administrative, classroom, supply, and locker areas, and approximately 8,597 square feet. Members of the teams will be traditional Guard members. Operational and maintenance costs for this facility, once construction is completed, will be 100 percent federally funded. With that, I would simply ask your approval of the resolution. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. It is a little buzzy in here at times. Members, if you could, please, appreciate you holding it down if you can. Open for discussion on LR 58. The question before the body is adoption of LR 58. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is LR 58, legislative resolution. Have you all voted who care to?
