SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Foley wishes to withdraw the amendment. Is that right, Senator Foley? It is withdrawn. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend, AM1360.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on AM1360.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I intend to withdraw AM1360. And since we're at the end of the day today, and I know the Speaker intends to adjourn at four o'clock, I would just as soon go ahead and do that. And I'll try to be in touch with as many of you as I possibly can tonight to see if there's anything else we need to do on the bill, or if there are 25 of you who are happy at this point. I hope there's a broad enough satisfaction with the bill to advance it. I appreciate very much all the work everybody has done on it. And with that, Mr. Clerk, I'd withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn, Senator Beutler. Mr. Clerk, do you have some items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Transportation offers a confirmation report. I have amendment to be printed to LB 367 by Senator Preister. Enrollment and Review reports LB 494 to Select File; LB 464, LB 480, LB 481, LB 521, LB 349, LB 498, LB 461, LB 548, LB 307, LB 149, LB 510, and LB 707, all to Select File, some of which have Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Mr. President, Senator Friend and Erdman would like to add their name to LB 95 as cointroducers. (Legislative Journal pages 1284-1286.)

I do have a priority motion. Senator Beutler would move to adjourn until Wednesday morning, April 16, at 9:00 a.m., Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to adjourn until tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m. All in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The ayes have it. We are adjourned.
