SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: (Machine malfunction)...W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Senators, the afternoon session is about to reconvene. Please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: I have no items at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You have an item on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I misspoke, I do have some items, so if I may...

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may.

CLERK: New study resolutions: LR 124 by Senator Smith; LR 125, Senator Smith; Senator Burling offers...LR 124, LR 125 are study resolutions; Senator Burling offers LR 126, which will be laid over. (Legislative Journal pages 1779-1780.)

Mr. President, when the Legislature recessed, Senator Smith had pending AM1884. Senator Smith, I now have an amendment from you, Senator, to AM1884. This is FA1360. (Legislative Journal page 1780.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, you're recognized to open to that amendment to AM1884 to LB 407.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, the amendment to the amendment simply specifies that it's Cash Funds instead of General Funds, very simple. There was an error, unintended, and so this amendment would clarify that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. You've heard the opening on FA1360. There were several lights on before lunch and, Senator Smith, yours was the first one.
