SENATOR BAKER: Same...

SPEAKER BROMM: This is the penalty on the wireless.

SENATOR BAKER: Same exact situation there. I think it was about a three-line change to the statutes.

SPEAKER BROMM: And this amendment is as the bill was introduced and...

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...and as killed by the committee?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay. And then it's...the other one, the other two are LB 530 and LB 531. Is that correct?

SENATOR BAKER: That is correct. They were both Public Service...well, actually, they're all Public Service Commission bills, yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: And there were no opponents to any of these bills.

SENATOR BAKER: There was no opposition to any bill at any stage here, none.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay. Well, thank you, Senator Baker. It just caught my eye that we would...that we're amending bills in that have been killed by the committee and so I was curious about that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I passed out a sheet that says LB 321 on it by Wehrbein, which is my part of this amendment, and I want you to look. It's raising the Public Service fees and you can look across on that chart, I won't go into the detail, but it's the type of fee, the current
