Cunningham. Senator Kremer, please report to the Chamber. Senator Chambers, do you wish to wait for Senator Jones and Senator Kremer for this "to-for" amendment? Thank you, Senator Chambers. Proceed to vote. And we'll do a machine vote. The question before us is the adoption of FA1401 to AM2066. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. I do raise the call. Do you have items, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. New bills. (Read LB 1031-1032 by title for the first time.) I have a series of amendments to be printed: Senator Smith to LB 452; Senator Baker, LB 559; Senator Baker, LB 560, LB 532, LB 609, LB 279, LB 452; Senator Schimek to LB 172. And Senator Chambers, a motion with respect to LB 172. New resolutions: LR 215, by Senator Foley; LR 216, Senator Foley; LR 217, and LR 218 by Senator Foley. All will be laid over. Transportation Committee, notice of hearing for Tuesday, January 20. And the last item, Mr. President...next to the last item, lobby reports, as required by statute, to be inserted in the Legislative Journal. And I have a series of adds: Senator Erdman to LB 110; Senator Quandahl, LB 172; Senator Maxwell, LB 304; Senator Thompson, LB 304; Senator Tyson, LB 816; Senator Cunningham, LB 825; Senator Stuhr, LB 850; Senator Cunningham, LB 852; Senator Mossey, LB 880, LB 881; Senator Quandahl, LB 892; Senator Vrtiska, LB 933; Senator Synowiecki, LB 933; Senator Connealy, LB 934; Senator Janssen, LB 934; Senator Cunningham, LB 943; Senator Hartnett, LB 976 and LB 977.
