SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day this morning is Pastor Gerry Sickler, Christ Unity Church, Lincoln, Nebraska, and that's in Senator Beutler's district. Chaplain.

PASTOR SICKLER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you Pastor Sickler, for being with us. We appreciate it. I call the fifth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, just one item at this time. The Retirement Systems Committee offers a notice of confirmation hearing, and a hearing on LB 961. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 241.)

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. LB...
