SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Baker, could you approach the Chair for just a moment? Stand at ease for a moment. You may sit at ease as well. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senator Baker, Senator, I assume you would prefer to ask unanimous consent to bracket the bill, bracket LB 532, until January 28, 2004.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Baker has asked unanimous consent to bracket the bill till...was it the 28th, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER BROMM: Twenty-eighth of January. Are there any objections? The bill is bracketed. Mr. Clerk, do you have some items?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1080-1085 by title for the first time.) Mr. President, a series of amendments to be printed: Senator Smith, an amendment to LB 452; and Senator Chambers to LB 609. A series of adds, Mr. President: Senator Stuthman to add his name to LB 304; Senator Cunningham, LB 879; Senator Aguilar, LB 934; Senator Stuthman, LB 1049; Senator Mossey, LB 1056. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 272-279.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Members, tomorrow at 10:00 a.m. is the State of the State Address. We will convene at 9:00 and continue with...actually we're going to do a couple of Select File bills, hopefully, and then we'll come back to the General File agenda. So with that, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a priority motion: Senator Redfield would move to adjourn until Thursday morning, January 15, at 9:00 a.m.

SPEAKER BROMM: It's a motion to adjourn. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned.
