SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. You've heard the closing on the committee amendments to LB 236. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the committee amendments to LB 236. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. Back to discussion of LB 236. Anybody wishing to speak to the advancement of LB 236? Senator Maxwell, there are no lights on. You may close if you care to.

SENATOR MAXWELL: I will. Thank you, Mr. President. So friends, now that it's been amended, this simply brings state law in harmony with federal law in this area. The parties that were opposed at the hearing agreed on the amendment that we just adopted. So all the interested parties are in agreement. I simply urge your advancement of LB 236. Thank you, Mr. President.
