will the schools be harmed if they post this information? How will anybody be harmed? I don't believe the schools are harmed under the law as it exists now, and no school could show any harm. There has been no outcry against the present law. My amendment need not be adopted. I think we should, to the extent that we can, focus on the serious aspects of the issue before us. I needed an opportunity to discuss Senator Schimek's amendment. That was one of the reasons I offered mine. Amendments of a substantive nature I would offer to the bill itself, and not to Senator Schimek's amendment. But I do think if anybody was paying attention to what she said about the origin of this amendment, it will not be difficult for that person to support it. I hope there will be the support. And in order not to detract from the good discussion that Senator Schimek has given us, the information Senator Landis has offered,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...I will, in a few seconds of the one minute that I have, Mr. President, withdraw that pending amendment that I have up there now.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk,...

CLERK: Mr. President, just...

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...items.

CLERK: ...some items. Thank you. Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading this morning were presented to the Governor at 9:55 (re LB 355, LB 810-813). New resolution, LR 230, offered by Senator Combs. That will be laid over. Confirmation reports from the Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Revenue Committees, signed by their respective Chairs. Notice of hearing from Natural Resources and from Health and Human Services, again, signed by their respective Chairpersons. Amendment to be printed: Senator Schrock to LB 32. Senator Chambers has designated LB 1085 as his priority bill for this session. And a new A bill: LB 644A, by Senator Hartnett. (Read LB 644A by title for the first time.) That's all that I had,
