February 12, 2004 LB 559A

ASSISTANT CLERK: Next bill, Mr. President, is LB 559A. I do have E & R amendments. (AM7170, Legislative Journal page 505.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 559A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt E & R amendments to LB 559A. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Thompson would move to amend with AM2585. (Legislative Journal page 610.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM2585, to LB 559A.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you, Mr. President. This amendment is brought in order for the department to make some adjustments to their...with software, and also to change some forms. They're one-time costs of \$18,400. This is a result of the amendment we put on yesterday to create the Nebraska Donor Registry, so that people who have signed up on their...at the time of their driver's license to be an organ and tissue donor will have that information transmitted to the Nebraska Organ Retrieval System, so that people can know their wishes who will be involved in that decision making if they are dying or recently dead. So this is the money that it takes to be able to implement that. It is a one-time cost. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Thompson. You've heard the opening on AM2585, offered by Senator Thompson to LB 559A. Open for discussion. Seeing nobody wishing to address it, Senator Thompson, do you wish to close? She waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM2585 to LB 559A. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the Thompson amendment, AM2585 to LB 559A. Has everybody voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
