of Elkhorn not want it? I think Elkhorn should have a say within their county. If there are some more appropriate boundaries to be drawn for the purposes of local approval of a casino, I'm open to suggestions, but no one filed an amendment on this. And certainly I would be open to ideas, but here's what we have. We use the county boundaries as a mechanism for a lot of things. As I said earlier, HHS follows a lot of their statistics by county, and so I think it's very reasonable and I would adopt...or I would urge the adoption of AM2599 to LR 14CA. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. You've heard the closing on AM2599 to LR 14CA. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Question before the body is AM2599. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.
