SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on FA1531 offered by Senator Chambers to the first division, FA1502, of the divided committee amendments to LB 962. Open for discussion on that amendment. Anybody wishing to address the Chambers amendment? There are no lights on, Senator Chambers. He waives closing. The question before the body is FA1531 to FA1502 to LB 962. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of FA1531 offered by Senator Chambers to the first division of the divided committee amendments. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. FA1531 has been adopted.
