SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, no closing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Question before the body is adoption of FA1551, offered by Senator Chambers to AM2963 to LB 906. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is Chambers amendment FA1551. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: At this time, Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the Stuhr-Jensen-Bourne amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I want my time to be running, but even though we're going to have an amendment that might make unnecessary what I'm jotting down here, I want to put it on the desk just in case. So I know my time is running.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, did you wish to go to your amendment right away, or do you wish to use up your three minutes?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'd like to go to the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, when you get time.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend Senator Stuhr's AM2963. (FA1552, Legislative Journal page 939.)
