ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself. Senator Hartnett, did you wish to speak, or did you wish to close?

SENATOR HARTNETT: I'll just speak that I appreciate Senator Louden's remarks and the work of the Government Committee. And like Senator Schimek says, the committee amendment becomes the bill, and I'd ask for advancement of LB 1231.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Were you closing, Senator Hartnett?
