CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Amendments to be printed: Senator Chambers to LR 209; Senator Erdman to LB 1084. Enrollment and Review reports LB 826A to Select File. And, Mr. President, a series of study resolutions: LR 302, Senator Kremer; LR 303, Senator Wehrbein; LR 304, Senator Wehrbein; Senator...LR 306, Senator Mines; LR 307, Senator Landis, and LR 308; LR 309-312, Senator Smith; and LR 313, Senator Combs; (also LR 305, Senator Schrock); all study resolutions. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1314-1320.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now move on to Select File, 2004 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Select File (LB 888). Senator Mossey, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator. (AM7184, Legislative Journal page 988.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 888.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 888. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment, Senator Synowiecki, AM3076.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Synowiecki, to open on AM3076 to LB 888.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Mr. Clerk, I'd like to withdraw that amendment and take up the next amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: No objection? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Synowiecki would move to amend
