was conducted at a level, and sustained over a longer period of time, than I've seen since I've been in the Legislature. But nevertheless, it was like the mountain...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...that rumbled and roared and gave birth to a mouse. The fact is nothing concrete was done. The only way something could be said to have been done is if the form of LB 1090 had changed. It has not changed. So nothing of a legislative nature was done. Nothing of a lawmaker...of a lawmaking nature or bill-altering nature was done. But I do not believe that what has happened was in vain, nor do I think it was a waste of time. And, Mr. President, I'm going to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. AM1657 is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: No further discussion? Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1090 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1090 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. There's been a request for a machine vote. The question before the body is, shall LB 1090 advance to E & R for engrossing? All in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. The question before the body is to advance LB 1090 to E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1090.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1090 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next legislative bill.
