And you as sponsors and introducers of those bills probably have a better idea of what's doable and what isn't. We will have a pretty good day on Tuesday that we'll need to put in. We'll have a number of things that will need to advance from Select File, a couple of things that need to be worked out between people between now and then to put us in a position to pass them. And Tuesday is the day that, if we advance something from Select File, we'll need to wait till it gets back down here so that it can lay over Wednesday to pass on Thursday. And I also know that some things are going on Tuesday night, but some of us will need to perhaps stay here for awhile in order to allow that to happen. So I just want to say that you have done a great deal of work this week. I appreciate the...what you've done and the way you've done it. And with that, I would move that we adjourn until tomorrow morning, April 8, at 9:00 a.m.
