A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to cities of the first class; to amend section
2 16-672.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 change provisions relating to storm sewer districts; and
4 to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 16-672.01, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 16-672.01. Supplemental to any existing law on the
4 subject, whenever the mayor and city council of any city of the
5 first class in Nebraska, shall deem it advisable or necessary to
6 construct storm water sewers and appurtenances in any section of
7 the city and the ~~territory one mile beyond its corporate limits~~
8 extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city as established
9 pursuant to section 16-902, together with outlets for the same, the
10 advisability and necessity thereof shall be declared in a proposed
11 ordinance, which ordinance shall state the kinds of pipe proposed
12 to be used, and shall include cement concrete pipe and vitrified
13 clay pipe and any other material deemed suitable and shall state
14 the size or sizes and kinds of sewers proposed to be constructed
15 and shall designate the location and terminal points thereof. The
16 ordinance shall refer to the plans and specifications thereof which
17 shall have been made and filed with the municipal clerk by the city
18 engineer before publication of such ordinance. Such city engineer
19 shall also make and file, prior to the publication of such
20 ordinance, an estimate of the total cost of the proposed
21 improvement, which shall be stated in ~~said~~ the ordinance. The
22 mayor and city council shall have power to assess, to the extent of
23 special benefits, the cost of such portions of ~~said~~ the
24 improvements as are local improvements, upon properties found
25 specifically benefited thereby; and the ordinance shall state the
26 outer boundaries of the district or districts in which it is
27 proposed to make special assessments.
