Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB490 clarifies that owners of self-propelled equipment designed and used exclusively to carry and apply fertilizer, chemicals or related products to agricultural soil and crops, agricultural floater-spreader implements and other other implements of husbandry designed for and used primarily for tilling the soil and harvesting crops or feeding livestock, or power unit hay grinders or a combination that includes a hay power unit and a hay grinder when operated without cargo are not required to comply with the Certificate of Title Act but, at the option of the vehicle owner, may apply for a certificate of title.
