This bill would change provisions relating to the criminal responsibility of intoxicated persons and the insanity defense. It would change provisions relating to the defense of not responsible by reason of insanity.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that the fiscal impact is not determinable. DCS notes that the current inmate population is 4,599 (1/18/2011 Tuesday Count), and the FY10 per diem (cost per day of feeding, clothing, housing, medical, etc) for an individual inmate was \$5,625 per year.
