This bill would change provisions relating to life imprisonment without parole.

It appears that this bill will have either no fiscal impact or a minimal fiscal impact. The Nebraska Supreme Court estimates no fiscal impact. The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that it has had only 14 inmates total in the last ten years that had life sentences who were paroled. Therefore, DCS estimates a minimal impact.
