Sec. 19-4401 currently provides metropolitan, primary, and first class cities authority to include provisions that authorize and regulate planned unit developments within such cities' zoning ordinances. LB146 would extend this authority, with limitation, to second class cities and villages. Any impact upon relevant political subdivisions would be contingent upon indeterminate actions of second class cities or villages to exercise the authority that would be granted under LB146.
