This bill would change family law provisions relating to court orders, forum, child support, and visitation.

The Supreme Court estimates a one-time cash fund expenditure of \$5,000 for training for all judges and court staff on the new schedule and guidelines. Their response follows:

LB 147 requires the Supreme Court to develop a standard visitation schedule and advisory guidelines for developing parenting plans. The schedule and guidelines are to be reviewed and updated periodically and made available to parties in certain actions. There is no significant impact estimated for developing and distributing the schedule and guidelines. However, Cash fund expenditures from the Supreme Court Education Fund for training for all judges and court staff on the new schedule and guidelines is estimated at \$5,000. In addition it is possible that judicial workload could be affected by provisions such as development of an education subsidy in child-support orders, but any impact is not estimated to be significant.
