LB 249 would amend the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Statute Sections 53-101 and 53-177, to allow the Liquor Control Commission to issue a waiver on the restriction of selling alcoholic liquor within 300 feet of the campus of any college or university in the state.

The Liquor Control Commission estimates an increase in the number of retail applications and a decrease in the number of special designated license applications.

It appears that there will be no additional cost to implement LB 249.

There is no basis to disagree with the Commission's estimate of fiscal impact.
