LB 279 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Statute Section 53-169.01, to prohibit all manufacturers of alcoholic liquor and beer from any interest in any alcoholic wholesaler. Current statute contains an exception for a manufacturer of beer.

As amended by AM694 and AM1173, a manufacturer of beer may under certain circumstances acquire an ownership interest in a beer wholesaler for a period not to exceed two years.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
