LB 45 amends the Nebraska Engineers and Architects Regulation Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 81-3401 to 81-3455. The bill updates and clarifies language, provides for enrollment of engineer-interns who are enrolled in another state or any foreign country, changes a dollar amount limitation for public works projects, and slightly broadens the expense reimbursement provisions for members of the Board of Engineers and Architects.

The Board of Engineers and Architects estimates that the enrollment of engineer-interns will increase by 20 to 25 individuals and the increase in application revenue will be approximately \$600 to \$750 annually based on an anticipated application fee of \$30 per application.

While the Board does not expect an increase in expenditures from the broadening of the expense reimbursement provisions, the possibility of a slight increase does exist.
