LB 789 adds “installations for grain handling and irrigation equipment regardless of location” to the list of installations for which inspection and enforcement of the State Electrical Act shall be applied.

The State Electrical Division is unable to estimate the fiscal impact of this change due to the unknown number of instances that will occur and the type of systems that will be encountered.

At this time, the Division does not anticipate needing to hire additional inspectors. Inspection work is fee based, so the work would be self-funding. If such a need presents itself, the Division will request adequate Cash Fund authority to address the need.
