LB 875 prohibits the use of a handheld or interactive wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle which is in motion in a school crossing zone or a maintenance, repair or construction zone. A person who violates these provisions is guilty of a traffic infraction and is to be assessed points on his or her operator's license. The bill establishes a fine of \$200 for a first offense, \$300 for a second offense and \$500 for a third and subsequent offense.

The Department of Motor Vehicles indicates the bill will have no fiscal impact for the department to incorporate the traffic violation into the point system.

Individuals convicted of violations will pay a \$200 to \$500 fine pursuant to the bill. It is assumed there will be an increase in revenue from traffic violations pursuant to the bill. It is also assumed there will not be a significant number of convictions, so the revenue from fines will be minimal. Revenue from fines accrues to the county where the violation occurs for use by public schools
