LB939 would change statutorily specified means of delivery of notices of court proceedings to sureties and conservators. Currently the specified means of delivery is registered or certified mail. LB 939 would change the means of delivery to regular mail or electronic media. Any related impacts upon postage expenses borne by counties would be contingent upon the number of affected notices and which of the alternative means of delivery were to be elected to be used under provisions of the bill.
