LB 98 would provide the necessary authority to allow the Department of Roads to buy federal-aid transportation funds from political subdivisions or public corporations. The Department is allowed to purchase the funds at a discount. The political subdivisions or public corporations are required to use the proceeds from the sale on transportation projects.

LB 98 will not have a direct fiscal impact since it is simply authorizing legislation. Any fiscal impact should the Department choose to exercise the bill's provisions and buyback federal funds from local agencies will depend on the amount bought and the discount rate.
