**LEGISLATIVE BILL 624**

Introduced by Wishart, 27.

Read first time January 18, 2017

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to provide for withholding
- 2 the residential address of a law enforcement officer from the
- 3 public; and to provide an operative date.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Unless requested in writing, the county assessor and  
2 register of deeds shall withhold from the public the residential address  
3 of a law enforcement officer who applies to the county assessor in the  
4 county of his or her residence and pays a fee of twenty-five dollars. The  
5 application shall be in a form prescribed by the county assessor and  
6 shall include the name, address, and certified law enforcement  
7 identification number of the law enforcement officer and the parcel  
8 identification number for his or her residential address. The county  
9 assessor shall notify the register of deeds regarding the receipt of the  
10 fee and a complete application. The county assessor and the register of  
11 deeds shall withhold the address of a law enforcement officer who  
12 complies with this section for five years after receipt of the fee and a  
13 complete application. The law enforcement officer may renew his or her  
14 application every five years upon payment of the fee and submission of an  
15 updated application.

16           Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2018.
