LB 193 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 53-1,115 and 84-914.

The bill amends Section 53-1,115 to provide that the costs of any proceedings under this section shall be paid by the applicant or in the case of suspension, cancellation, or revocation of a license by the licensee. Current law provides that such costs is paid by the party or parties against whom a final decision is rendered, in other words the losing party.

Section 84-914 is amended to provide that in contested cases before the Liquor Control Commission all costs of the formal hearing shall be as provided in Section 53-1,115, the above section.

The Nebraska Liquor Control Commission has indicated they expect no fiscal impact.

We agree with the Commission's estimate of fiscal impact.


