This bill establishes the Concussion Awareness Act. The provisions of the act apply to approved or accredited schools including public, private, denominational and parochial; and any city, village, business or nonprofit organization that organizes an athletic activity in which the athletes are 19 years of age or younger. These schools, subdivisions and organizations must provide training approved by the Board of Medicine and Surgery on how to recognize the symptoms of a concussion or brain injury and how to seek proper medical treatment in addition to other requirements. Nothing in the act shall be construed to create a liability or modify the liability or immunity of any school, city, and village, business or nonprofit.

The training materials are already available. This bill does not have a fiscal impact.
