This bill eliminates the Commission on Indian Affairs and Commission on Latino Americans and replaces it with a new Commission on Indian and Multicultural Affairs.

The appropriations for state agencies for FY 12 and 13 have not been set. However, the agencies' budget requests can serve a guide to the approximate amount that may be appropriated. The amounts requested by the Commission on Indian Affairs and Commission on Latino Americans are as follows:

With this bill, the appropriations to the Commission on Indian Affairs and Commission on Latino Americans would be eliminated. The amount of freed up general funds that could be used for the Commission on Indian and Multicultural Affairs is \$436,000 each year. Since the Commission on Indian and Multicultural Affairs is new and the duties assigned to it are general in nature, the Legislature would decide the level of funding.

Position Breakdown:

1 Executive Director to carry out strategic plan of the board of directors.

1 Administrative Assistant III to assist Executive Director in carry out all aspects of agency strategic plans.

3 Administrative Assistant IIs. One AAII devoted exclusively to assisting in fostering government to government relationships between Nebraska Tribes and State and Federal Government. Two AAIIs to assist in serving minority constituencies including Latino, African American, Asian, Sudanese and others.

1 Public Information Officer to disseminate information to the public and constituencies via website, newsletter and other public outlets.

1 Administrative Secretary to serve answer phone and direct calls, intake of constituent requests, bill and payroll entry. Should be bi-lingual.

Explanation of Estimate:

In order to fully fulfill the functions of a multicultural commission, the proposed Commission on Indian and Multicultural Affairs would need to reflect the cultural and ethnic diversity of the State of Nebraska not only at Board level, but also at staff level. The three states where this approach has been taken (Nevada, South Carolina, and Washington) have all had to go through this process.

Full time staff would be an Executive Director. The Executive director would be in charge of conducting Board meetings, defining strategies, writing out the strategic plan and defining the goals of the different branches of the Commission. Salary for the Executive Director has been calculated at \$75,000.00 or \$36.05 hourly.

Four different full staff Coordinators for each of the ethnic groups. The Coordinators would be responsible for outreach to their different communities (African American, Native American, Latino American and Asian American) identifying issues affecting the communities, proposing strategies to solve those issues, researching culturally competent interventions, guaranteeing SMART objectives (Specific , Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, and Timely). Salary for the Coordinators has been calculated at \$ 40,000.00 each or \$ 26.44 hourly.

Four staff assistants. Staff assistants need to be familiar with the ethnic group represented, bi-lingual if necessary (Spanish or Arab) and posses sufficient customer service skills to deal adequately with the multiplicity of issues that they will encounter. As an example, the Latino American Commission currently receives 1400 calls and 400 clients per year, all dealing with specific problems concerning Latino American citizens. These positions have been calculated at \$ 34,000.00 each or \$ 16.35 per hour.

Four Information officers in charge of creating, updating and linking websites, some of which will have to be bi-lingual (Spanish, Arabic), creating brochures and informational literature and newsletters, and establishing a relationship with the media. Each position has been calculated at \$ 32,000.00 per year.

Benefits for the above positions add up to \$ 174,650.00. Operating expenses of \$32,000.00 per year for each of the subdivisions and traveling expenses estimated at 1000 miles per month for each ethnic group represented; at current rate of \$.51 per mile complete the estimated fiscal impact.
