LB 1044 requires the Public Service Commission (PSC) to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to establish appropriate safety standards and practices applicable to the transportation of hazardous liquids and hazardous liquid pipeline facilities, including both publicly and privately owned facilities, which are not subject to exclusive federal control.

The PSC must submit the necessary certifications and reports and take any other necessary action in accordance with federal code to comply with requirements for intrastate certifications and interstate agency agreements. In addition, the PSC shall pursue designation by the US Secretary of Transportation as an agent to conduct safety inspections of hazardous liquid pipeline facilities located in the state.

The PSC estimates the need to hire three inspectors to address the provisions of LB 1044. Their estimate includes start-up costs, lodging and travel costs, and a vehicle for each inspector. There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.
