This bill would change harassment protection order and domestic abuse protection order provisions.

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions.

The Supreme Court's response follows:

LB 920 may decrease the number of domestic abuse hearings. The effect on judicial workload would be difficult to determine, but is not estimated to be significant. Statute currently requires a court to immediately schedule a hearing. Under LB 920, hearings will be scheduled only upon request by the respondent.
