**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

With respect to first and second class cities as well as villages, LB801 amends provisions relating to notices to abate and remove nuisances and related hearing and appeal processes. Current law provides that such notices are to be delivered by personal service or certified mail. LB801 provides that the municipalities are to establish the method of delivery by ordinance. This change may impact related notice delivery costs; however, any impacts would be dependent upon the future actions of the affected municipalities in terms of the manner of notice delivery they elect to adopt by ordinance.
