Explanation of Estimate:

LB 258 creates an interstate compact for licensure of physicians and osteopathic physicians. The purposes of the Compact are:

To develop a streamlined process to allow physicians to become licensed in multiple states, enhancing license portability while ensuring patient safety;

To create another pathway for licensure;

To affirm that the practice of medicine occurs where the patient is located at the time of the physician-patient encounter, and to require the physician to be under the jurisdiction of the state where the patient is located;

To ensure that states participating in the Compact retain jurisdiction to impose adverse actions against a license issued through the Compact; and

To create the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission.

There will be fiscal impact associated with this bill; however, it is difficult to estimate how significant that impact will be. The annual assessment paid to the Commission is not yet determined, and the bill does not include a cap for the amount of the assessment. It is not known how many Nebraska-licensed physicians would be interested in pursuing an expedited license through the Compact. Additional fees that will be established by the Compact will be charged for initial and renewed licensure through the Compact, and this will be new revenue in addition to what is currently collected for physician licensure. There will likely be costs associated with the development of the database used for Compact licensure, and it is anticipated that these costs would be born, at least in part, by the member states. Thus the Fiscal Impact to the Department of Health and Human Services is Unknown.
