This bill redefines the definition of employer for purposes of age discrimination cases filed with the Nebraska Equal Opportunity Commission. The number of employees employed by the employer is lowered from 25 to 20.

Although this would allow more cases to be filed with the commission, the number is not expected to be large. The agency can handle the additional cases with current resources.
