Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 58 requires school boards to establish policies and procedures to allow students from schools which elect not to meet approval and accreditation requirements (exempt home schools) to participate in extracurricular activities and events. The policies may require such students to enroll in no more than one course offered for credit by the school district. Such students will not be eligible for transportation, except to or from practices or events, to the same extent as public school students.

The bill will increase the workload of school boards to develop policies and procedures pursuant to the bill which may result in a one-time minimal increase in expenditures. Since extracurricular activities and events of school districts are currently offered by school districts, there should be little, if any, fiscal impact to increase the number of participants.

The provision of the bill which allows a school district to require students from exempt home schools to take one course in order to participate in extracurricular activities may impact the number of students in course offerings. However, since the language is permissive, it is assumed the bill will have a minimal, if any, fiscal impact for schools to include such students in courses offered by a district.
