**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB 819 expands the allowable uses of inmate welfare funds to include providing inmates skills to assist in their reentry and family friendly visitation activities. The inmate welfare fund consists of revenues from pop and canteen sales inside the institutions and is currently limited to being used for recreational equipment and activities. The current balance in the fund is approximately \$570,000. NDCS estimates the changes from LB 819 to increase expenditures from the inmate welfare fund by \$75,000 in FY 18-19 and \$75,000 in FY 19-20 as the department provides additional family friendly visitation activities and opportunities for inmates to acquire skills to prepare for reentry.
