LB 1002 requires insurers providing group health plans covering 51 or more employees to provide an annual report prior to the contract renewal date of claims paid and premiums by coverage lines. Violations of the requirement are subject to the Unfair Insurance Trade Practices Act.

The bill has no fiscal impact for any state agency or political subdivision. Any fines paid pursuant to violations are projected to be minimal. Fine revenue accrues to the Permanent School Fund, the interest from which is allocated to public schools.
