LB 1041 would require that surface or ground water purchased or leased by the state or natural resources districts (NRDs) shall be fully protected and accounted for by the Department of Natural Resources from the point of diversion to the intended destination or use of the water, except for normal carriage loss. The Department of Natural Resources estimates that it would require 7 FTE staff to carry out more extensive surface and ground water modeling and to ascertain compliance with the provisions of LB 1041. Total expenses for salaries, benefits and related operating and travel costs would total approximately \$475,000 to \$500,000 General Funds annually.
